A policy has been put in place within the Education Department for the Seminole Tribe of Florida. It has been approved through both the Executive Administrative Office (EAO) and IT.

The following is an excerpt from the Seminole Tribe of Florida regarding the use of devices.

Purchasing Agreement Policy

Tribal Member Students will be issued the required device from the approved device list of the Seminole Tribe of Florida. The first device issued will be at no cost to the tribal member.

If the first issued device is broken/damaged by the assigned student and deemed unusable:

- The Tribal Member student or parent/guardian is responsible for paying half the price of the second issued device.

If the second issued device is broken/damaged by the assigned student and deemed unusable:

- The Tribal Member student or parent/guardian is responsible for paying the full price of the third issued device.
